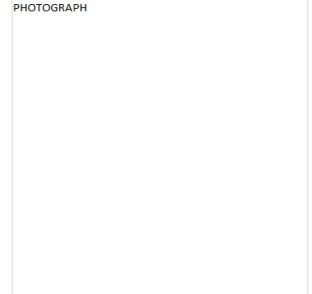

I have always been a curious and inquisitive child. Owing to my supportive parents and privileged upbringing I have had the opportunities to realize several of my aspirations and pursue my interests. From a very young age, I was interested in multiple things and participated in almost all extra-curricular activities that my school had to offer. I moved to Canada for three years in 2011 to live with my grandparents so my mother could pursue her masters in fine arts. There I was exposed to an entirely different set of new experiences, adjusting to a new country and living without my father and brother was painful and difficult but I had a chance to grow a lot as a person.

While my mother was busy with her coursework and subsequent internship, for the first time in my life I had the freedom to choose what I wanted to do with my time instead of having every minute of every day planned. I decided to take up ballet as part of my extra-curricular activities in school and ended up liking it so much that I started learning it at an advanced level and now I have a professional degree in Classical Ballet. After school I would spend my time at my grandparents' organic produce shop where I often was the cashier. On the weekends I would visit my mother's art studio where she was interning and would learn about the various art movements and listen to her talk about contemporary artists and art works with her clients. When it was time to leave Canada at the end of three years, I was as upset as I was when I had to move there in the first place.

After coming back, I joined my old school and had a hard time adjusting to life here but I decided to not dwell on the difficult parts too much and immersed myself completely in the course work and continued to pursue the activities I had picked up in Canada. In the tenth grade, I became part of the organizing committee of Career Day at my school and as member of the Guest Management Delegation, I had the opportunity to interact with a human rights lawyer who works with the XYZ Foundation. As she explained her work and talked about her clients who are often victims of terrible abuse and come from family that have been historically socio-economically disadvantaged, I became quite certain of my interest in the field of human rights. I continued to be in touch with her and earlier this year when she offered me an internship position at her organization, I was more than happy to take it up.

As part of the research wing of the organization for close to three months, I had the chance to be a part of framing some very important PILs for underrepresented voices of the society and learn from them the intricacies of their fight for fundamental right and justice. My work with the foundation has been the most satisfying and rewarding experience and has given me a push to pursue a career in the field of social justice policy research. I strongly believe that an education at Ashoka University will not only equip me with the conceptual and theoretical knowledge but also provide an environment that helps in developing a sensitivity and maturity in understanding such complex issues.
