FEE STRUCTURE AND REFUND POLICY (AUGUST 2019 INTAKE)

COMMENCEMENT DATE OF ACADEMIC SESSION – 19th AUGUST 2019

(The commencement date of the academic session is the formally-notified last date of admission)

Acceptance Fee and Security Deposits (To be paid by Round-Wise Acceptance Deadline)

The candidate will be required to deposit an amount of INR 2,95,000 to confirm his/her offer of admission by the acceptance deadline of the round in which s/he has applied.

This above-given Acceptance Fee amount includes the following:

- Admissions Fee of INR 35,000
- Tuition Fee of INR 1,85,000
- Refundable Security Deposit of INR 50,000
- Refundable Meal Cost Security Deposit of INR 25,000 (One-time payment to be refunded at the time of graduation from Ashoka University or withdrawal of admission)

Semester 1 Fee Deposit

(To be paid by August 10, 2019)

The candidate will be required to deposit the remaining Semester 1 Tuition Fee and Residence Cost of INR 2,62,500 to ensure that s/he secures their seat in Ashoka University's Undergraduate Programme for the session commencing on August 19, 2019.

This amount includes the following:

- Remaining Semester 1 Tuition Fee of INR 1.85.000
- Semester 1 Residence Cost of INR 77,500

Semester 2 Fee Deposit

(To be paid by mid-January 2020)

The candidate will be required to deposit an amount of INR 4,47,500 toward their Semester 2 Fee.

This amount includes the following:

- Semester 2 Tuition Fee of INR 3,70,000
- Semester 2 Residence Cost of 77,500



Ashoka University Refund Policy and Amount

[Details on Withdrawal of Admission as per University Grants Commission Guidelines]

- 1. If a candidate withdraws his/her admission before or on August 3, 2019 the candidate will receive a refund of the entire Security Deposit of INR 75,000 and a 100% percent refund of the remaining fees paid, less a 5% deduction as administrative processing fee subject to a maximum of INR 5,000 (If withdrawal of admission is 15 days or more before the commencement date of the academic session)
- 2. If a candidate withdraws his/her admission from August 4, 2019 to August 18, 2019, the candidate will receive a refund of the entire Security Deposit of INR 75,000, and 90% of the remaining fees paid (If withdrawal of admission is less than 15 days before the commencement date of the academic session)
- 3. If a candidate withdraws his/her admissions on August 19, 2019 i.e. The commencement date of the academic session/last date of admission, the candidate will receive a refund of the entire Security Deposit of INR 75,000, and 80% of the remaining fees paid
- 4. If a candidate withdraws his/her admission from August 20, 2019 to September 3, 2019, the candidate will receive a refund of the entire Security Deposit of INR 75,000, and 80% of the remaining fees paid (If withdrawal of admission is 15 days or less after the commencement date of the academic session)
- 5. If a candidate withdraws his/her admission from September 4, 2019 to September 18, 2019 the candidate will receive a refund of the entire Security Deposit of INR 75,000 and 50% of the remaining fees paid (If withdrawal of admission is 30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after the commencement date of the academic session)
- 6. If a candidate withdraws his/her admission after September 28, 2019, none of the fees paid will be refunded. The candidate will only be refunded the Security Deposit of INR 75,000 (If withdrawal is more than 30 days after the commencement date of the academic session)

Please note the following:

- The above refund details are based on the amount(s) deposited by the candidate within the given payment deadlines of Ashoka University
- The refund amount will differ for candidates based on the amount of financial aid granted to them
- All refunds will happen within 15 days from the date of request for withdrawal of admission
