The challenge of being caught up in an attempt to keep everyone happy and provide comic relief is that I never stopped to think about what I was like when I was by myself. It was only after I transitioned to senior school (Grade 10 onwards) that I found myself amidst a sizeable number of people that let me be myself. I rediscovered interests and passions I had sidelined and found that those give me joy even in the absence of company. Over time, I have started to engage in various activities by myself and find that I often find those much more enjoyable. The ability to do so has exposed me to experiences I would not have normally had and given me the confidence to explore interests that I never considered as a part of a crowd.

Subsequently, it has led me to be empathetic, yet stand for the choices I make.
