What is an idea, concept, or theory that you find interesting and why? In what ways have you examined and engaged with this topic? [400 words]

As a history enthusiast, I keep frequenting museums. During my visit to the National Museum in Delhi, I attended a talk on the historical importance and relevance of museums. Since museums house objects which help us understand facts of periods in history, I never questioned the existence of museums. On reading a book, 'Lives of Objects: Stories from the Indian Museum', I realised how the existence of museums in India was an imperial activity, an institution established by our colonizers to produce knowledge about those whom they colonized. I was surprised to read that native people were not allowed inside the Indian museum, and the few who eminent people who were had to follow strict Western dress codes. Upon entering, these people would find their clothes as objects of curiosity and study, preserved in the museum, but they could not enter wearing these clothes.

This was a revelation for me for I used to take history for granted and used to think of museums as keepers of history. Now I understand that what we understand as history is someone interpreting, arranging, organizing, and presenting facts to us. My fascination with history started because I used to think it was an objective discipline. During one of our discussion groups in class, my teacher mentioned the term 'historiography'. I could not believe that not only was history not without its bias, but there was a field of study dedicated to the act of writing and recording history, something that I thought existed naturally.

I use this lens to understand my encounters with history, be it at museums, cinema, television, newspaper, or even books. I engage with the subject matter of the concepts but I also read about the people behind a particular work, what school of thought they belong to, what their biases and primary influences are, where funding for various activities and projects comes from. I have keenly participated in online workshops offered by museums across the world where they open their galleries on digital viewing platforms. , it has been a fascinating and eye-opening discovery to see how many museums house artifacts foreign to them because these artifacts were taken from colonies. This has made me interested in the future of reparation work such that places like museums where people access history get a semblance of fairness.

My life's circumstances have made me exacting, often having to work hard without any optimal outcomes. Growing up with comfortable but limited means has contributed to this. I used to believe that for experiences to be worthwhile, I had to put in much tenacity and rigour. If I did not feel wrung by the end of the process, I did not deserve the outcome. This year, my parents encouraged that I travel by myself to experience self-reliance. I joined a traveling club where I went to Munnar with a group of acquaintances. One early morning we were in the bus, with faint but recognisable music in the background, and cool breeze. When I looked back to see my fellow travellers, everyone looked effortlessly happy. That moment I realised that it was possible to feel significant without having to doggedly work at it. It taught me to be kinder with myself.

I feel insecure about not knowing Hindi well, especially when I travel towards Hindi speaking regions. My Hindi teacher who grew up in Lucknow, keeps telling us about this mishmash language Hindustani. As she traverses between Hindi-Urdu, she keeps telling me how I should have "aazaad-khayaal" (independent thoughts/imagination, freedom of thought/imagination).

As a person born into technology and social media, I often resign my "aazaad-khayaal" to the people of the internet. I start following trends, stuck in loops of endless scrolling, forgetting that I, too, could be a person with "aazaad-khayaal". When I want to assert my personhood and remind myself that among my many freedoms, the most private and dear one is that of imagination, I rely on a phrase so foreign to me, and tell myself: I am not a mere mouthpiece of my times, I am a person with a rich inner life and imagination.
