

Guide to Filling the Undergraduate Application Form (2026)

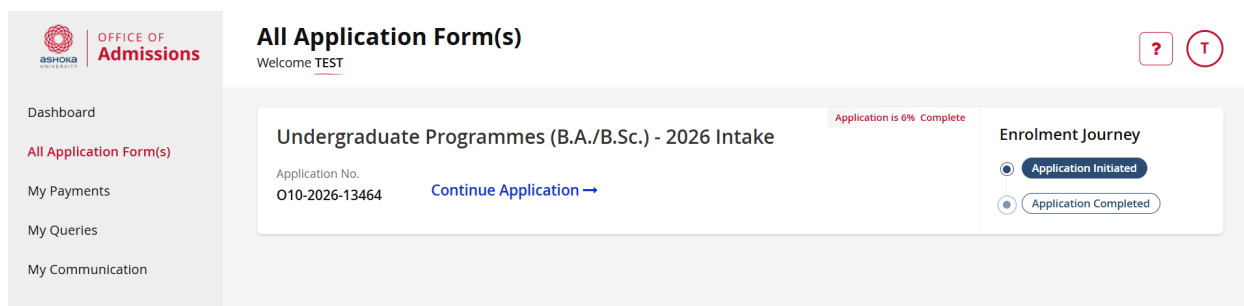
The following document contains a step-by-step walkthrough of the Application Form. You can refer to [the Instruction Manual](#) while completing your application form for more details on each section.

Upon successful registration, you will receive an email to verify your email address. You will then receive a username and password to log in to the application portal. The application form has fifteen sections, including the “Admissions Policies”, “General Instructions”, “Admissions Assessments”, and “Declaration” sections.

You may navigate through different sections of the application by using ‘**Back**’, ‘**Save & Exit**’, ‘**Preview**’, ‘**Skip**’, and ‘**Next**’. The ‘**Save & Exit**’ button saves the information entered and returns to the “**All Application Form(s)**” screen. You may click ‘Save & Exit’ in case you wish to gather any information or documents before completing your application.

In case of any queries, while filling out the application, you may check the following

- a. **Mandatory/ Optional indication:** The red star (*) next to any textbox indicates a mandatory section. If a text box does not have the red star, you may choose to write information that applies to you. For a holistic assessment, we strongly recommend sharing relevant information even when it is not marked mandatory.
- b. **Information boxes:** You will be able to see additional clarifications about required information through **pop-over information boxes (i)** over certain sections.
- c. **General Application Queries (Non-technical):** In case of any case-specific queries that you believe are not answered by the information boxes, you may write to ugapply@ashoka.edu.in, and our representative will get in touch with you. Prepare your application with adequate time, so we can assist you in resolving any queries.
- d. **My Queries (Technical):** In case of any application errors or glitches with your application, you may raise a query through the ‘My Queries’ section available on the left. In this case, your query will be responded to through the application portal, and you may track it under the ‘My Queries’ section.
