About Ashoka: Ashoka University is India's first Liberal Arts University (non-profit) built on the principles of collective public philanthropy. It offers undergraduate education across humanities, sciences and social sciences and encourages pluridisciplinarity.

About the Department: The Department of International Relations seeks to understand international and global affairs in their manifold complexities from a variety of standpoints. The department's research and pedagogical orientation are self-consciously interdisciplinary. Faculty members in the department include political scientists, historians, distinguished practitioners, and scholars. Their research ranges from gender and utopianism in international politics, to international histories of India and South Asia, and contemporary globalization and geopolitics in Asia.

We are looking to fill 2 positions of Teaching Fellows in Foundation Courses in IR for the academic year 2023-24. Subject to budgetary approval, these positions will start in the Spring term (late January).

Roles and Responsibilities:

The TF is expected to support faculty in delivering the course. The TF's responsibilities include

- Ensuring that all course materials are available to the students on the AMS
- Leading four Discussions Sections of an hour every week.
- Keep office hours every week to meet students (minimum 3 hours a week)
- Assist in conducting and grading all assignments
- Manage the overall logistics of the class, including taking attendance.

Qualifications: Doctoral students of Political Science and International Relations or candidates who have completed a Master's degree in these subjects are encouraged to apply.

Accommodation: The University helps TFs find accommodation on campus (upon availability) or in the campus- vicinity (Parker Residence) but does not cover the rent charges.

Compensation: Commensurate to qualifications and as per the standard TF policy of the University.

Application Procedure: Fill out the attached form and provide your CV, a coverletter as well as a writing sample. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted.
