## **Teaching Fellow Position in Psychology at Ashoka University**

Applications are invited for the position of Teaching Fellow (TF) for Psychology courses for the academic year 2025-26. These positions will start from the Monsoon term (August 20, 2025).

**Qualifications:** Applicants must have completed Bachelors in Psychology (or allied areas) from a recognized institution. Candidates with a post-graduate (M.Sc. / M.A./ M.Phil.) degree who exhibit strong skills in undergraduate level Psychology subjects like Statistics and Research Methods, Neuroscience, Cognitive Psychology, Social Psychology and related courses will be given higher consideration.

**Responsibilities:** The duties of a TF include attending lectures, helping the faculty instructor with grading and other logistics, in addition to leading at least three discussion sessions (DS) per section each week. In DSs and during office hours a TF is expected to help students understand the ideas and concepts introduced in the course. The total workload per week is expected to be around 20 hours. Please apply for the position only if you are available to work on-site at Ashoka's Sonipat campus. The classes will be held offline at Ashoka.

**Appointment, housing and salary:** The appointment will be for one semester starting from the third week of August 2025. Ashoka helps TFs find accommodation in apartments in the neighbourhood of the university. The compensation will be Rs. 42000 per month for one regular course and Rs. 66000 per month for the foundation course. If a TF takes 2 regular courses simultaneously, the remuneration will be Rs. 66000 per month. A TF can take up two courses per semester. Other terms will be as per Ashoka University policies.
