

Teaching Fellow Position in Biology at Ashoka University

Applications are invited for the position of Teaching Fellow (TF) for the undergraduate Biology course Introduction to Biology I: Genetics and Evolution for the academic year 2025–26. The appointment will begin in the Spring Term (January 2026).

Qualifications:

- Applicants must have completed a Master's degree in Biology or allied areas from a recognized institution.
- Candidates with experience in or strong familiarity with evolutionary biology will be preferred.

Responsibilities:

The duties of a TF include attending the lectures, helping the professor with grading and other logistics, in addition to leading discussion sessions (Discussion Sessions), and holding office hours each week. In DSs and during office hours a TF is expected to help students understand the ideas and concepts introduced in the course, develop problem-solving skills, and, in general enlarge the intellectual imagination of the students.

The appointment will be for one semester starting from the third week of January 2026. Ashoka helps TFs find accommodation in apartments in the neighbourhood of the university. The remuneration will be Rs. 42000 per month for 3 Discussion Sessions and may increase depending on course enrollment.

1. Cover letter expressing interest and clearly stating their competence to be a teaching assistant
2. Resume
3. Undergraduate and graduate transcripts
4. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member who has taught the candidate at the graduate level (Masters). The recommender should email their reference letter to Puneet Kaur (biology@ashoka.edu.in).
5. The deadline for applying is January 13, 2026. Applications received after this date will not be considered.
